Hinrichs takes over as the new managing director of QS

Nienhoff hands over the baton after over 18 years

Today, QS is active in the key sectors of the food industry. Hinrichs adds: "Social and political pressure on the retail and food industry is increasing. For QS, it will be key to actively and reliably support our partners in the face of the various new challenges they face so that they can continue to offer safe and high-quality food."
